ABOUT GVMS AND GMR



WHAT IS GVMS?

GVMS stands for **Goods Vehicles Movement Service**.

This new system was put in place from 1 January 2022. It's the customs service used in the UK to create the GMR number, needed for moving goods into or out of Great Britain and Northern Ireland.

Without being GVMS registered and using this system to create the GMR, you won't be able to move anything in or out of the UK.

WHAT IS A GMR NUMBER?

GMR stands for **Goods Movement Reference** number.

It's a digital number created on the Gov UK website that allows vehicles to cross the UK border for both export and import.

It's created by uploading information into the GVMS portal.




When you log in, you'll see the below page:

View or create goods movement references (GMRs)

For each GMR the driver moving the goods will need to:

- · present a copy of the GMR at the port of departure
- use the <u>'Check if you need to report for an inspection' service (opens in new tab)</u> while crossing with the goods

You must complete all mandatory fields, but you can make changes at any time before the driver checks in at the port.

You will not be able to change the direction once you create a draft good movement reference.




The summary will show you whether the entry is correct with a green '**OK**', or incorrect with a red '**contains errors**'.

INSPECTION NEEDED?



Inspection needed

The goods under this goods movement reference (GMR) require an inspection.

What happens next

Report for an inspection of the goods at your port of arrival, unless you are arriving at:

 Dover, Eurotunnel or Holyhead You will need to report to an inland border facility (IBF). There is more
 <u>complete information about IBFs here (opens in new tab)</u>.

Fishguard, Heysham, Liverpool or Pembroke

You will need to report to the port's designated customs checking facility.

Other additional controls

Some movements may need additional controls, for example food, animals or organics. Check with your declarant.

If you are ending a transit movement

You must also present the goods at your nearest office of destination.

TERMINOLOGY



AEO	Authorised Economic Operator : An internationally recognised customs guarantee or 'trusted trader' status ensuring processes are met, meaning fewer customs checks needed.	EXW
CCI	Customs Clearance Information : Information provided to hauliers by exporter/importer which provides customs information.	FCA
ссо	Certificate of Origin : A certificate highlighting the exact origin of goods – where it was made – that affects duty, quotas, tariffs and more.	GMR
DAP	Delivery at Place : Incoterm or shipping term where EU importer is responsible for clearance, duties and VAT in the EU.	GVMS
DDP	Delivered Duty Paid : Incoterm or shipping term where UK exporter is responsible for clearance, duties and VAT in the EU.	IBF
EAD	Export Accompanying Document : Also known as EX or EXI in mainland Europe, a document created by exporter to export goods from the customs territory.	MRN
EORI	Economic Operator Registration and Identification Number : All hauliers must have a GB EORI to move in or out of the UK, regardless of where they're established.#	TAD
ENS	Entry Summary Declaration : This alerts the import border of the shipment's arrival and must be lodged at least 2 hours before arrival at border (1 hour for Eurotunnel).	VRN
EXS	Exit Summary Declaration : Created by the EAD, this alerts the export border that the shipment is on its way, allowing HMRC to know in advance which vehicles they will stop for checks.	UCR

ExWorks: Incoterm or shipping term that doesn't work in practice, we offer something similar called FCA+ (read more here).

Free Carrier: Incoterm or shipping term where EU exporter is responsible for origin clearance and UK importer is responsible for everything else.

Goods Movement Reference number: The final number asked for to get vehicles on the ferry. This is a barcode generated by a combination of documents uploaded to GVMS.

Goods Vehicle Movement Service: The UK customs service used to generate the GMR to move goods in and out of Great Britain and Northern Ireland

Inland Border Facility: A customs location used for vehicle inspections and to support clearance when travelling on a T-1.

Movement Reference Number: A barcode reference allowing movement, containing information such as transit document numbers.

Transit Accompanying Document: A document accompanying goods not cleared into free circulation at the first border, including a barcode scanned at each border.

Vehicle Registration Number: The registration number of the vehicle moving the goods, which forms part of the customs documentation.

Unique Consignment Reference: The number used to create the GMR, one needed for every 99 commodity codes (sometimes more than I UCR per consignment).
